1. Plan of Action to Improve the attendance of students in Classes

In Higher Education institutions attendance is quite critical to student and institute success. It is the key factor to provide students with access to resources, contextual information and relationship that will affect their knowledge significantly. Therefore we can implement specific strategies to improve students attendance.

The students are at the receiving end of criticism for purposely skipping classes but seldom do the institutes explore the core reasons for their absenteeism. Therefore, the teachers must work together with the institute to initiate or develop an appropriate strategy. They must devise a plan of action which includes identifying the units of study in the curriculum that the absentee students find redundant.

During college admission applications, students think they will attend classes regularly but fail to keep their promises. All it takes is continual, focused efforts.

1. Plan of action for community participation through conference on education in the college

The experience of the past decade has underscored the need for better governance of education systems in terms of efficiency, accountability, transparency and flexibility so that they can respond more effectively to the diverse and continuously changing needs of learners. Reform of educational management is urgently needed — to move from highly centralized, standardized and command-driven forms of management to more decentralized and participatory decision-making, implementation and monitoring at lower levels of accountability. Community participation is considered as the single most effective means of improving the functioning of colleges, with the education of students seen as the joint responsibility of home and college.

We will set up the interface between the college and the community. One can also observe a distinct shift from having informal parent teacher associations (PTAs) to the creation of formal School Management Committees (SMCs).
